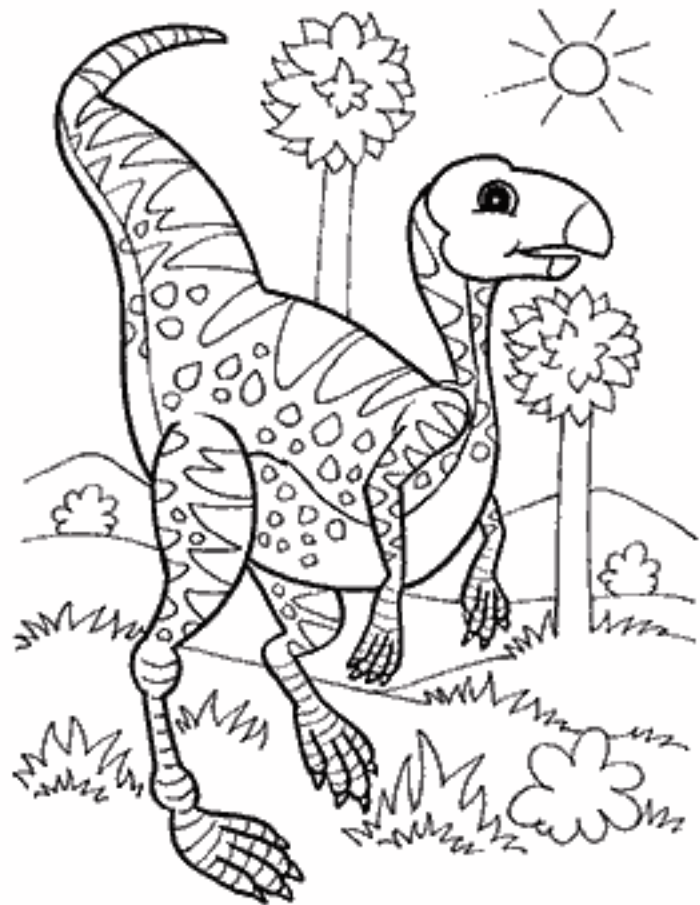

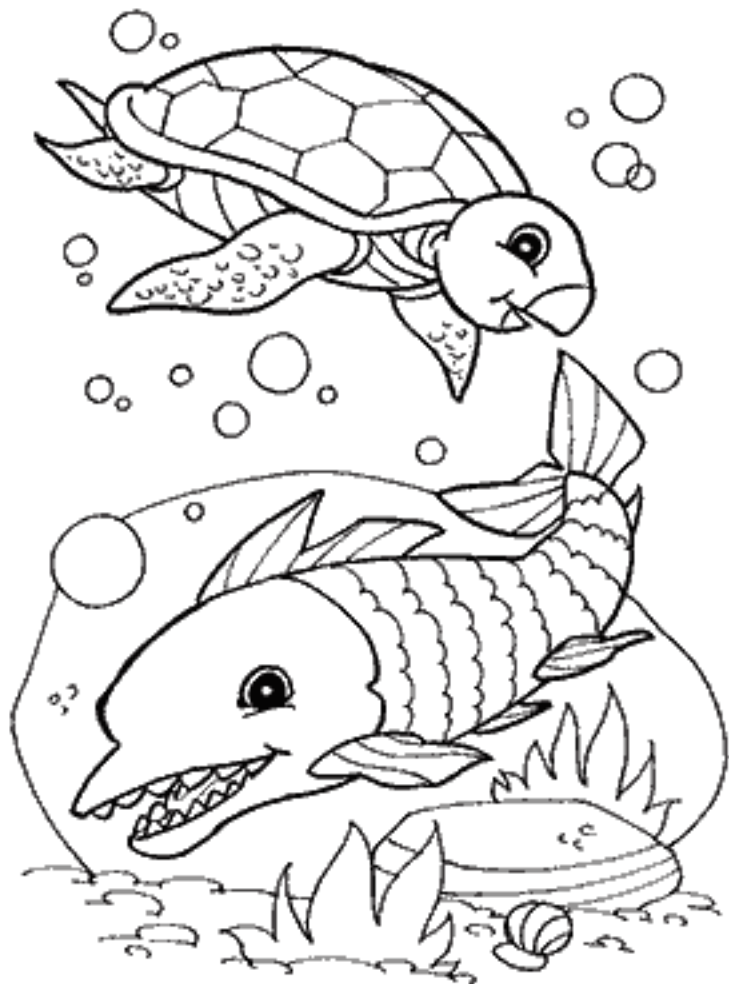
**My family is very, very old. Come with me,

Did you know that millions and millions of years ago, even before there were people, there were dinosaurs?



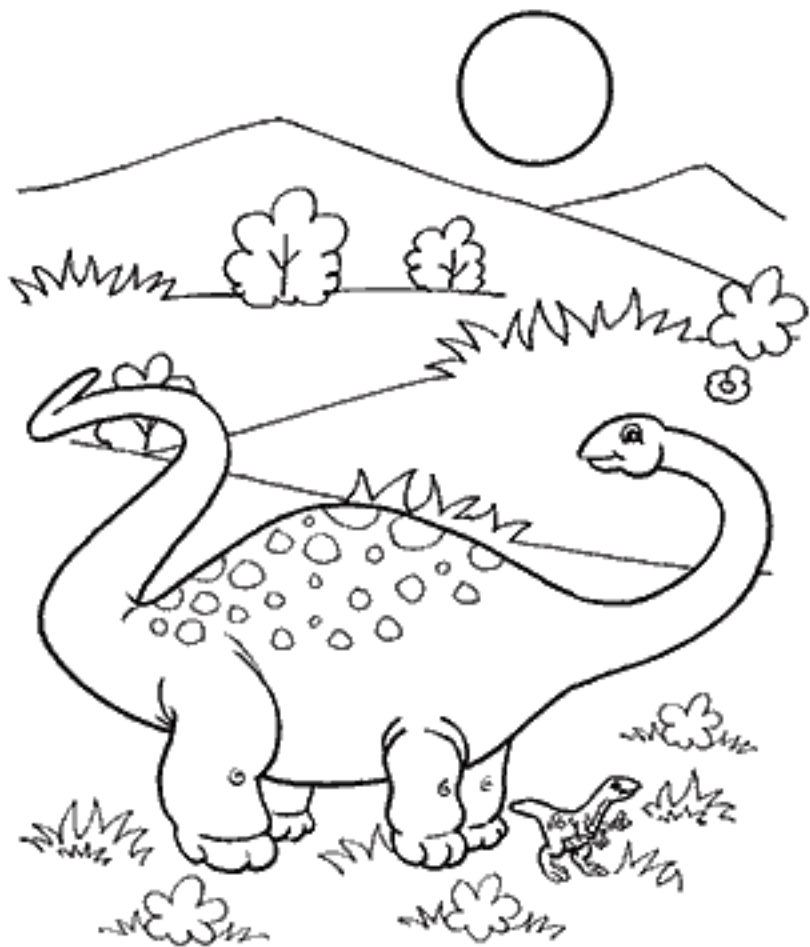
Many dinosaurs are reptiles. I guess you could say that dinosaurs are really, really enormously huge lizards. The Mesozoic Era was even called the "Age of Reptiles."



There were lots of other prehistoric animals that weren't dinosaurs. But there were a lot of animals that were closely related to us.



Dinosaurs lived only on land. Many reptiles who could fly and swim lived at the same time as the dinosaurs, although they were not considered dinosaurs.



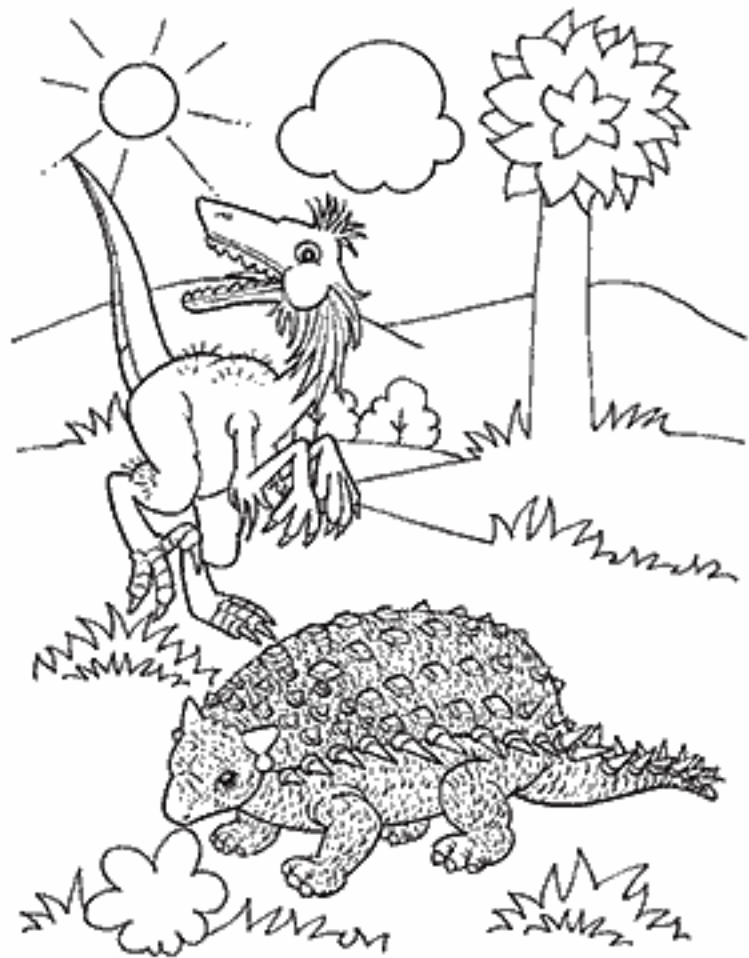
The largest dinosaurs were over 100 feet long and up to 50 feet tall. The smallest dinosaurs were the size of a chicken. Most dinosaurs were in-between.



Dinosaurs all looked different. Some were armor-plated, some had horns, crests, spikes, or frills - they had many colors and patterns on their bodies. Some had thick, bumpy skin, and some even had feathers!



In my family, most of us ate plants. We were herbivores. Today we would be called vegetarians. Dinosaurs like T. rex were carnivores who ate meat.



Some dinosaurs walked on four legs. Some walked on two. And some did both - when they felt like it. There were speeders like the Velociraptor. While others were in the s-l-o-w lane like the Ankylosaurus.

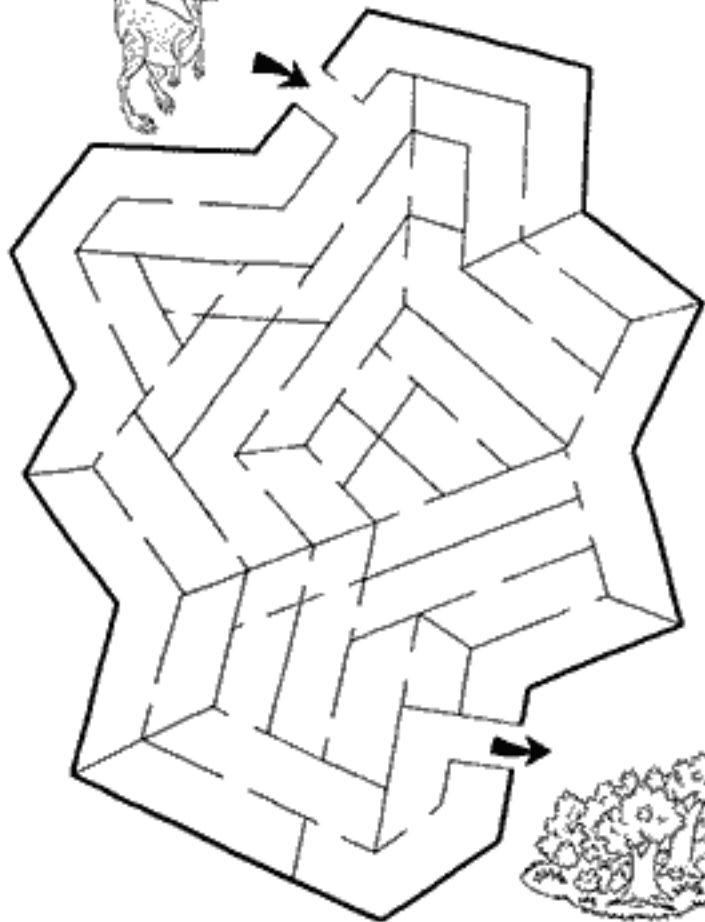
