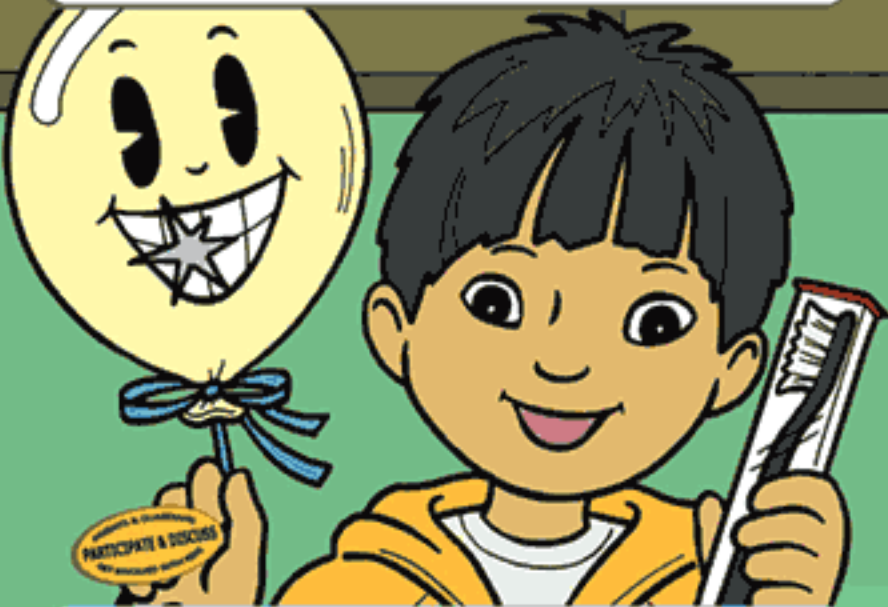

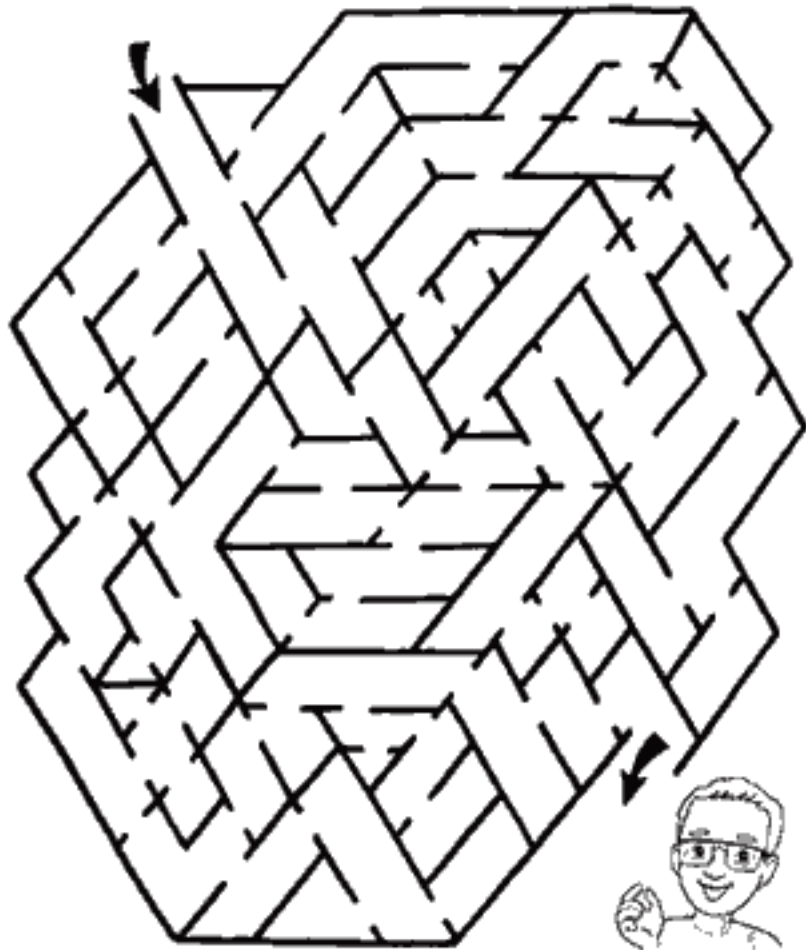

- What time is it when you have a toothache? Tooth Hurt-y (Two-Thirty)

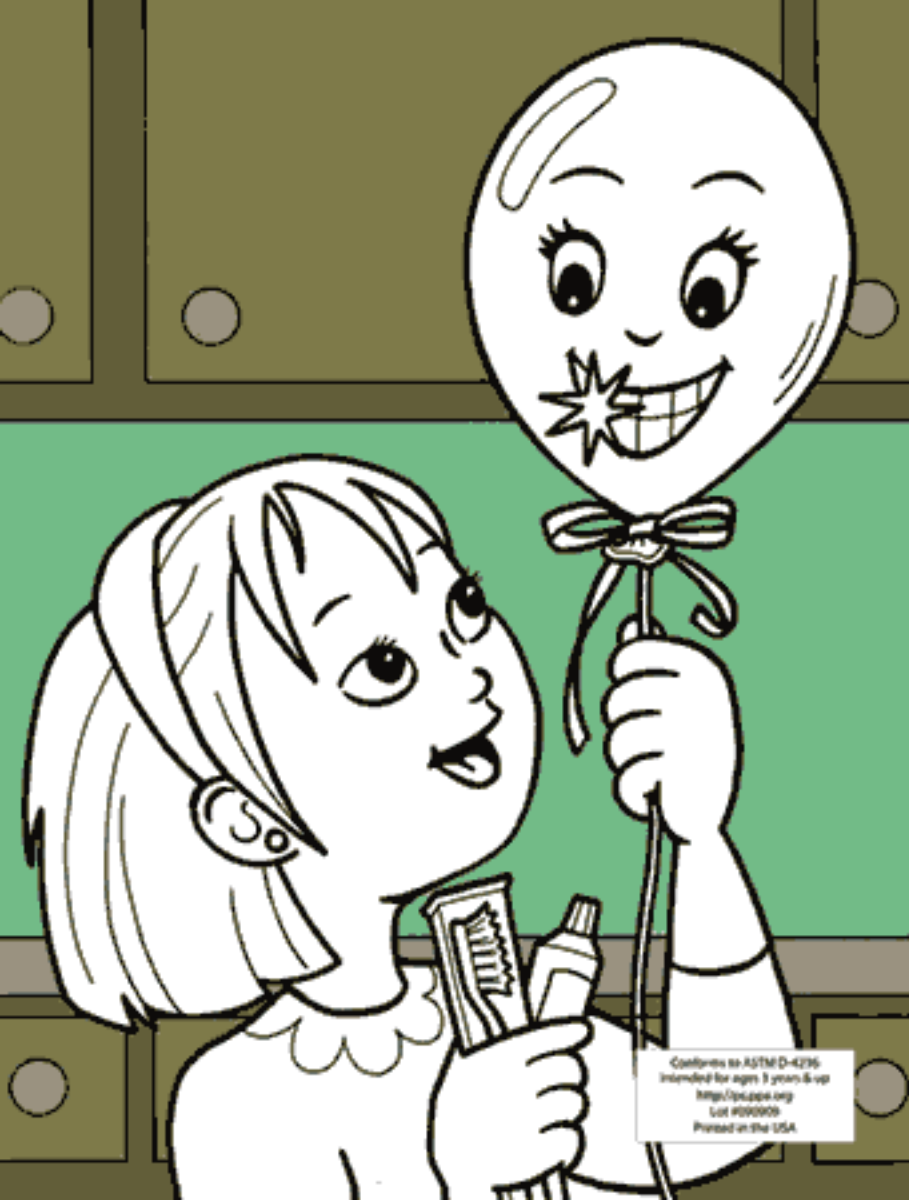
