**We help kids learn about fire safety. I tell kids
that it's important to plan ahead and prevent fires
before they happen!**

Fire safety starts with you!

- Have a family emergency escape plan.
- Every member of the family should know where to go and where to meet – like a neighbor's house.



If your home is on fire...

...you need to leave your home RIGHT AWAY!

And I mean NOW!!! Stay low and go!



- **Don't stop to take anything with you.**
- **Never go back into a burning building.**
- **Call 9-1-1 from a safe place and give the operator your name, your address and your phone number.**

**Smoke detectors never sleep
so you and your family can be safe.**



Test the batteries in your smoke detectors once a month. Change batteries every spring and fall.



**REMEMBER:
change your clock,
change your batteries!**

If your clothes catch on fire, remember
to **STOP, DROP AND ROLL!**

STOP

where you are.



DROP

to the ground.



ROLL!



over and over to smother the flames.

Cover your face with your hands to protect your face and lungs.

Remember...

- Stay away from hot surfaces like oven doors, coffee pots and irons.
- Be careful around stoves, heaters, barbecues and open fires.
- Smoke alarms tell you if there's smoke in the air with a loud noise. Their batteries should be changed every fall and spring.

Prevent fires with these fire safety tips!

Never, never, never, ever...

- ✓ play with matches or lighters or lit cigarettes and don't handle liquids like gasoline that can burn
- ✓ cook without a grownup
- ✓ touch radiators or heaters, stand too close to fireplaces, candles and space heaters
- ✓ play with electrical cords, put anything into a light socket or put anything over a lamp

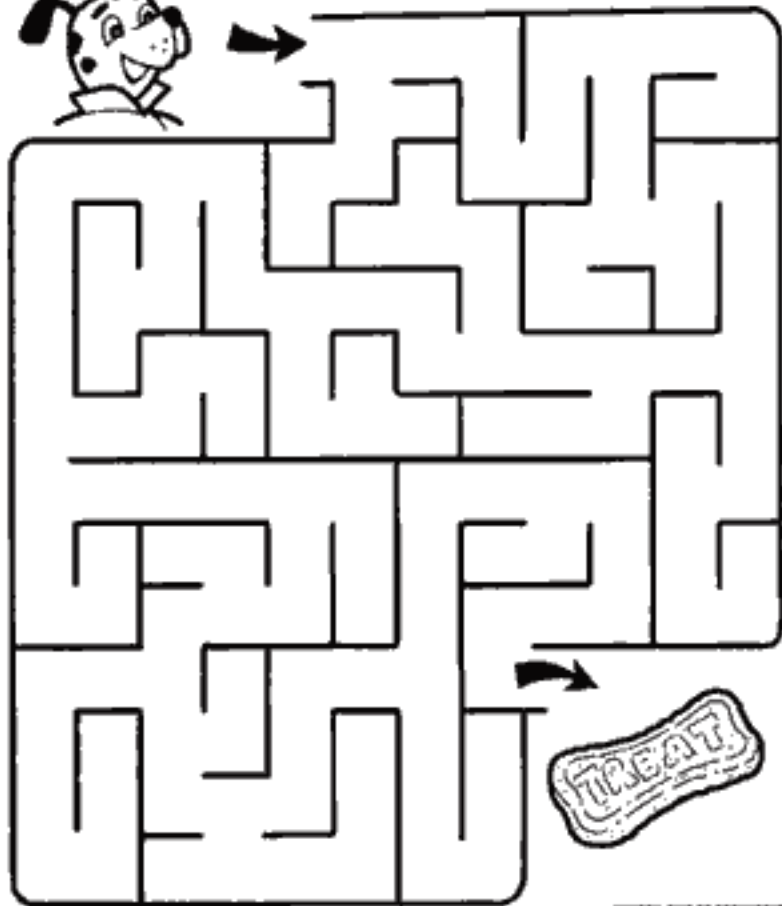

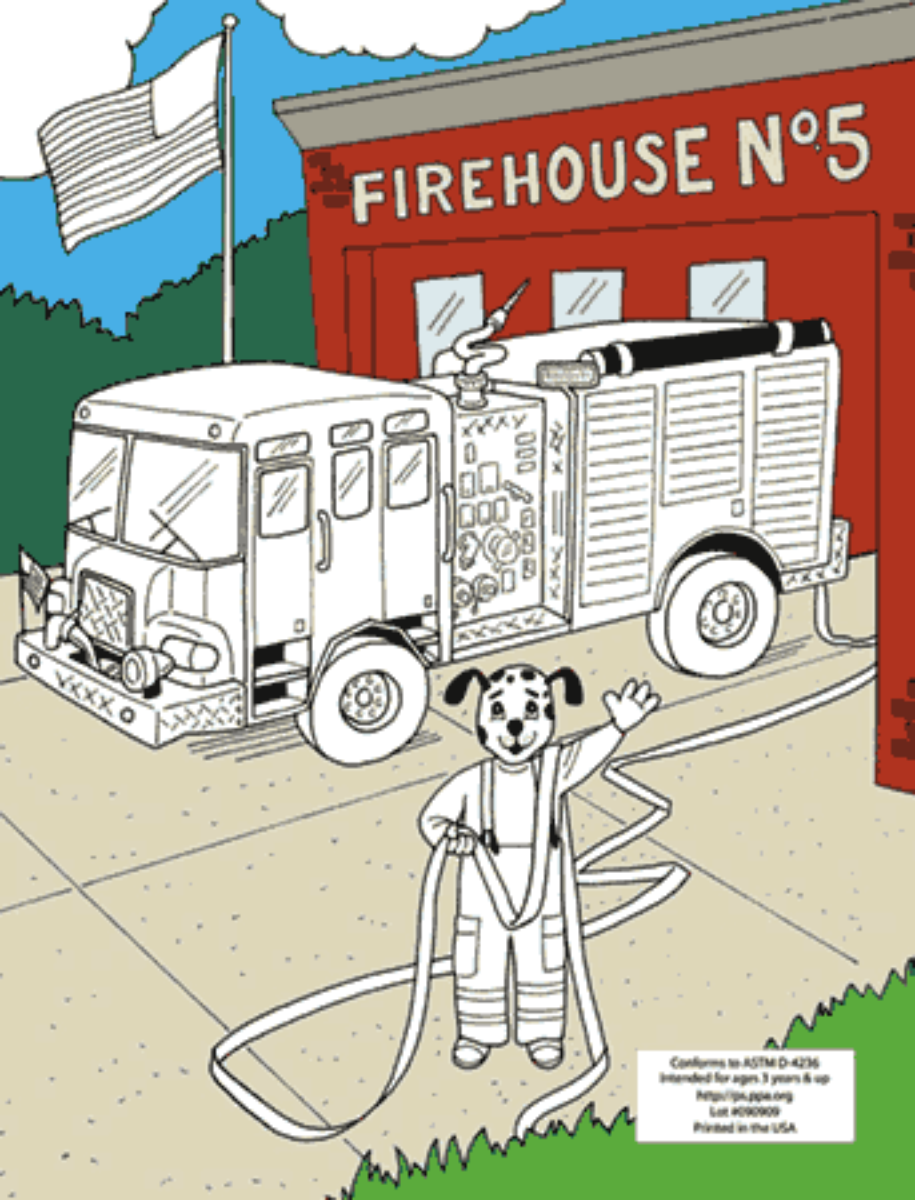
