**Numbers are something inchworms know a lot about.
Can you count along with me?
Ready? Set? Go! 1, 2, 3...**

Numbers are important.



Without numbers:

- You can't tell ball players without their numbers.
- You can't tell how many ice cream bars come in a package.
- You can't tell how much money you have in your pocket.
- You can't tell what time it is.



**When you say, "I want 3 cookies and 1 glass of milk"
– did you know that you are doing math?**

**When you say, I want 4 quarters to put in the arcade
game you are really asking for 1 dollar.
You're adding numbers.**



When you say, "I have to be at the birthday party at 3 o'clock" – you are using numbers to tell time.



Adding numbers is a way of counting. When you have 1 apple and 1 orange that makes 2 pieces of fruit. The answer to an addition problem is called a sum.



**You write an addition problem like this:
 $1 + 1 = 2$. That's how you add.**

Subtraction means to take away. The answer to a subtraction problem is called a difference. So when you have 3 cookies and you eat 2 – you are left with 1 cookie.



**Write a subtraction problem like this:
 $3 - 2 = 1$. That's how you subtract.**

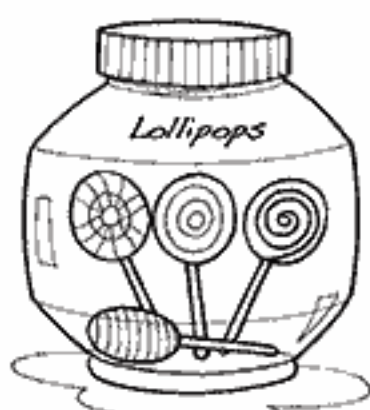


**You can have fun with numbers, too.

Iggy made 10 cupcakes. His mom made 6 more. How many cupcakes do they have?
