**First a bit about me! The zebra is a member of the horse family. My black and white stripes help me hide in the long grass.**



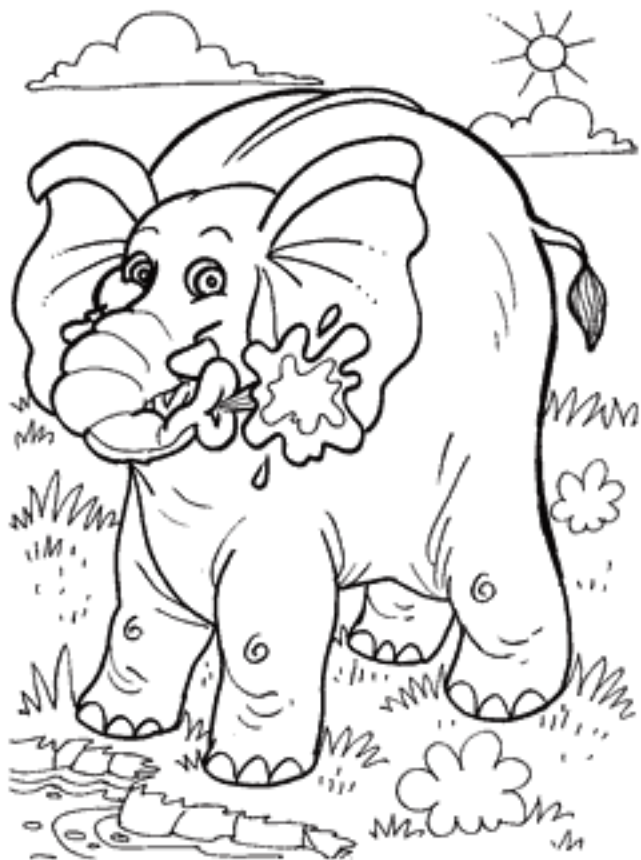
**Did you know that no two zebras have the same striped pattern?**

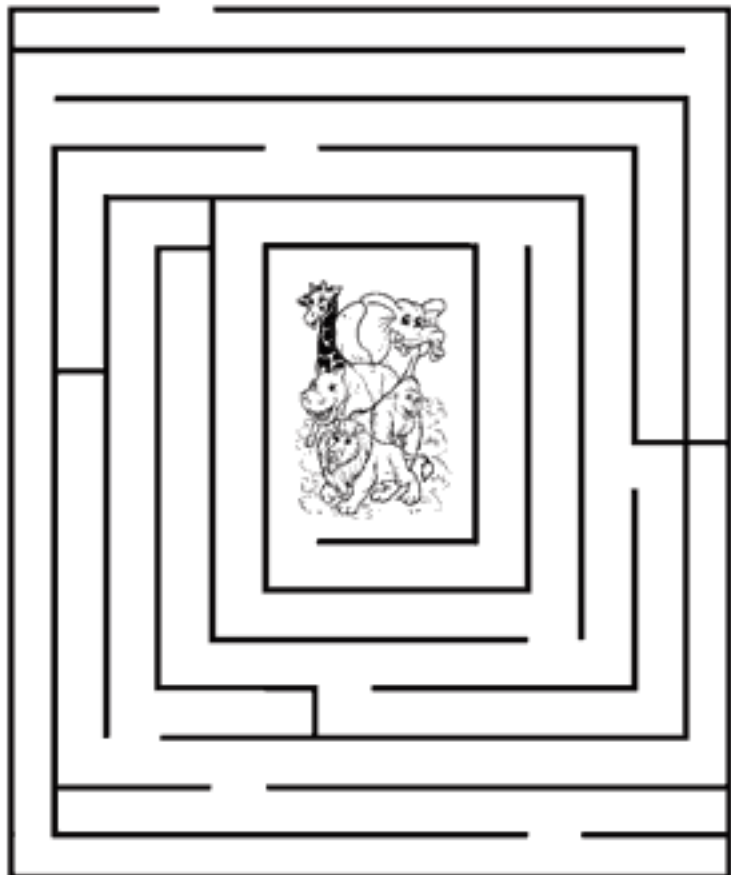
